

Antonella has worked on numerous commercial and residential projects, as well as many celebrity homes.


Also, for many years now she has been writing articles on tile and stone for the magazine, Kitchens, by professional designers. Her most recent article will be published in the new October issue.

## ROBIN NOWICKI ROBIN'S NEST HOME AND PATIO, LLC, MANALAPAN THE OUTDOOR PATIO




